SCIMP / SCANP THESAURUS

P R E F A C E

The 1980 edition of the SCIMP/SCANP Thesaurus incorporates the supplement which was issued in July 1979. It also includes 186 new terms which have been added mainly as a result of suggestions made by the librarians of the twelve business schools who participate in the indexing work for SCIMP. Many more relationship terms have been added and another comparison has been made with the second edition of the London Classification of Business Studies. This comparison was useful for establishing some of the new relationship terms and for amending others. The computer version of the SCANP Thesaurus has also been used to expand the number of relationship terms and the total is now nearly 6000 main and related terms.

As in the previous edition the names of countries have been taken from the Statesman's Yearbook. Large international organizations are included, but national organizations are excluded. Industry names have been included when obviously necessary. The usual abbreviations have been used as follows: BT = broader term, NT = narrower term, RT = related term, and SN = scope note.

Although the thesaurus is primarily an indexing tool for SCIMP and SCANP, and our intention is to update it annually with half-yearly supplements, it is also intended for use in retrieving information on-line from the SCIMP/SCANP data base held on the computer at the Helsinki School of Economics.

Steve Newman from the LBS Library, has been responsible for the task of amending the thesaurus which is stored on the School's computer; while I have been responsible for the editorial work. We are grateful for the advice and assistance of our colleagues in the LBS Computing Services.
